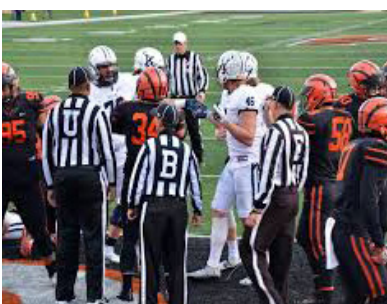

## No More Snow Days? *New HCPSS Policy*

In September, the Howard County Board of Education revealed that up to three inclement weather days can be substituted for asynchronous learning days. This decision came after the Maryland State Department of Education allowed local schools to implement asynchronous learning for inclement weather days.

According to the official Howard coun-



ty website HCPSS.org, asynchronous learning expectation will be that work must be completed and submitted in exchange for attendance. As for special education students, they will also be pro-

vided with asynchronous assignments that will accommodate their learning needs.

As for HCPSS staff, they will have responsibilities to uphold depending on the level they teach. Some of those re-

sponsibilities include surveying families to see which student will need hard copies of assignments, posting assignments within two hours of the beginning of the regular start time for students, and teaching a continuation of current content and not new topics.

The good news is, synchronous sessions are off the table. We will still have the freedom and flexibility of traditional snow days.

## Rescheduled Renovations for OMHS *Community Members Advocate for a Better Future*

Since 2009, OMHS has been scheduled to receive renovations, yet, renovations have continuously been delayed. Most recently, the renovations scheduled for 2026 were delayed until 2033. On September 21, the OMHS Student Executive Board held an assembly explaining exactly what that would mean for the school, urging students to testify at the HCPSS Board of Education meeting with their perspectives. Hundreds of students signed a petition to get the school renovated as soon as

possible.

At the HCPSS Board of Education meeting on September 22, 2022, numerous OM community members testified. The OMHS Student Executive Board



representatives stated that “The county has already deferred our school for so long that our HVAC system now requires a full replacement, our ceilings are leaking,

and panels are falling out. Another 10 years will exacerbate these problems.” Many OMHS students describe feeling unsafe at school and worried for their health. One student testified

“As a student, I do not feel safe going to school everyday knowing that we do not have the airflow to combat viruses like COVID-19. I also do not feel safe knowing

that mold has formed because the HVAC system cannot mix in fresh air while keeping humidity down.”

On September 29, 2022, the Board of Education voted 4-3 to make OM a priority. It was later announced that Oakland Mills was again scheduled for renovations in 2026. But, to many community members, the proposition to postpone the renovations to the school building even further was still another sign of the county’s willingness to neglect the needs of Oakland Mills High School students and staff members.

## The Invasion of Armenia *2022 Azerbaijani Illegal Action*

Recently, on September 12th 2022, the armed forces of Azerbaijan renewed their war with Armenia, leaving a trail of blood and death in their path. This causes a humanitarian disaster in the small country of Armenia.

This conflict is not new and has its roots in the fall of the Soviet Union where both countries fought over the land of Nagorno-Karabakh, a region legally inside of Azerbaijan but ethnically Armenian.

The first conflict ended with a ceasefire in 1994. In 2020, the two sides started fighting again, this time ending with neither side victorious. However, Armenian territory in Nagorno-Karabakh was lost to Azerbaijan.

The conflict reignited after Azerbaijani troops began firing and advancing through the mountains towards Armenian towns. After these first few clashes, it was discovered that Azerbaijani troops had massacred civilians and executed

Armenian prisoners of war. This led Armenia to call on the UN to denounce Azerbaijan's blatant war crimes while simultaneously calling on Russia and the Collective Security Treaty Organization to come to Armenia's aid. Yet, very limited action has been taken. Russia has refused to honor its alliance with their justification being that it can not spare resources due to the war in Ukraine. The UN has been quietly looking into Armenia's claims as more and more evi-

dence comes out, including videos spread by Azerbaijani soldiers proudly boasting about beheading and murdering Armenian civilians. Though many countries have stayed silent, the US has been vocal about how it will not let Armenia be trampled on easily and has sent several Delegates to Yerevan, the capital of Armenia, to discuss both humanitarian and military aid.

Although this is a heavy military conflict, it is important not to forget (*Continued on page 3*)

## Protests in Iran: *Supporting Mahsa Amini*

On September 16, 2022, 22-year old Mahsa Amini died in police custody in Iran. Three days before her death, Amini was arrested by the morality police of Iran for violating Iran's conservative dress code. She was in police custody for two hours until she was transported to the Kasra hospital where she was declared brain dead. Authorities have denied beating Amini and have stated that the cause of her death was sudden heart failure, but her family members have denied that she ever had any prior health conditions that could have led to heart failure. Amini's sudden death

has since resulted in worldwide protests against the Iranian government.

This incident happened in the capital city of Iran, Tehran. Some of us may recognize this name as the setting of the 10th grade graphic novel, *Persepolis*. Like the graphic novel displays, Iran has a very conservative and strict dress code, especially towards women. Unfortunately, Amini was arrested because authorities had accused her of not wearing her hijab properly. During her funeral, her mother



stated, "Why, why? My daughter had a proper Hijab and her coat was long and black, but I don't know why she was arrested." Authorities told Amini's family to not speak about her case, but that has not stopped the media from talking about it.

Many Iranians protesting Amini's wrongful death have faced deadly violence, internet restrictions, and mass arrests. The protests started in September, and have continued to this day. In order

to protest against the injustice, many young ladies have taken off their hijab and are waving them in Iranian schools and streets. They have also been chanting, "death to the director," towards Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei.

It is estimated that around 215 people have been killed during the protests since they started. Not only are many people getting arrested, but children who protest are being taken to psychological institutions. As more and more protests continue to rise, violence also rises. Although violence is rising, Iranian women continue to stand together in order to fight injustice.

## Midterm Elections 2022

### What Outcomes to Expect

On Tuesday, November 8, The United States will hold the 2022 Midterm Elections to fill the seats opening in Congress in the 2024 terms. This year, 35 senate seats and 435 House of Representatives seats will be changed, turned, and filled. Two-year House terms are coming to a close as well as some six-year senate terms, causing much anticipation within the country.

Historically speaking, it is common for the majority of Congress to be made up of the party opposite of the President. President Biden is a Democrat, meaning that if Congress followed historic patterns, Republicans would be the primary party representative in Congress. However, since the pushback surrounding the overturn of Roe v Wade in June, it is looking that Democrats may control Congress for another term.

Seats in both institutions

are very likely to flip this year, meaning occupants will switch from Democratic party to GOP and vice versa. Eric Garcia reporting for The Independent has predicted the top five states with the highest possibility of flipping seats

in the Senate. Nevada, currently represented by Democrats, is expected to flip to

Adam Lexalt, a Republican. Lieutenant Governor John Fetterman (D) of Pennsylvania is expected to replace current PA Senator Dr. Mehmet Oz (R). In Georgia, Herschel Walker (R) is leading Raphael Warnock (D) and is expected to take over the Senate seat. Wisconsin will likely be turning Democrat with Lieutenant Governor Mandela Barnes leading well ahead of the pri-



mary elections. North Carolina is witnessing the tightest race in the country between Cheryl Beasley (D) and Todd Budd (R), with Beasley in the lead at the time of publication

As for Maryland, Chris Van Hollen (D) is running for

his second term against Chris Chaffee (R) with polls on ballotpedia.org showing

favor towards Van Hollen. Current Governor Larry Hogan is finishing up his second and final term as the third most popular Governor in the United States, according to Morning Consult. The pre-election polls are favoring Democratic candidate Wes Moore over Republican Dan Cox to take Hogan's seat in office in 2023. According to WBALTV, "At this time

eight years ago, the New York Times-CBS poll showed Anthony Brown up 22 points over Larry Hogan. Hogan went on to win," showing that it is still possible for Cox to make a comeback.

In terms of the House of Representatives, many two year terms are up, meaning it is time to fill the House. Democrats have held the majority since January of 2019, and are predicted to hold it through this next election season. On The Late Show with Stephen Colbert, current House speaker Nancy Pelosi said, "I believe that we will win the House—hold the House...And we will hold the House—by winning more seats."

Elections will take place November 8 with results being updated live. Stay tuned for election results and to see who takes Hogan's seat!

## Becca Bakes: Easy Fall Soup

Becca Bakes is back from a long summer break! In this edition of Becca Bakes, I will be sharing a recipe for a very delicious and easy fall soup that can be paired with biscuits. This recipe was passed down to me from my mother and grandmother and has been a staple in my house my entire life during the fall season. It is super easy to make and is perfect for a fall party or a cozy family dinner. Let me explain how it is made!

The soup is mainly a vegetable-based soup and can be made with any variety of vegetables that you prefer. For my recipe, I make it with my favorite fall vegetables which are green squash, butternut squash, red and yellow onions, carrots, celery, yellow



squash, and broccoli. I cut the vegetables into one-inch chunks and place them on cookie sheets which are lined with parchment paper. After all the veggies are cut and placed on the cookie sheets, I coat them generously with extra virgin olive oil, salt, pepper, garlic powder, paprika, onion powder, and a very tiny sprinkle of nutmeg. I use my hands, that are washed and clean, to mix the veggies together with all of the oil and spices. To my oven that is preheated to 400 degrees Fahrenheit, I put the vegetables

in and let them cook for about 30 minutes or until the veggies are soft and cooked through.

After the veggies are cooked thoroughly, I take them out of the oven and begin to prepare to make the

soup. To prepare, I take out a large pot, a blender, chicken bone broth, and light cream. I begin making the soup by adding increments of vegetables and a splash of bone broth to the blender. I blend the veggies and broth until the soup is smooth and there are no chunks of veggies. I then pour the soup into my pot and set the heat to low to keep the soup warm as I blend the remaining veggies and broth. There are no exact measurements for this soup, therefore

you can make as much or as little as you would like. After all the veggies have been blended and the soup is in the pot, I like to taste the soup and season to my preference as well as add a splash of light cream to make the soup creamier.

Ta da! The soup is done! This soup can be paired with biscuits or little sandwiches to make this a complete dinner. I love this recipe and how delicious and easy it is to make. In my house, my family calls this soup “Grampy’s Soup” since it was made by my great-grandfather. I hope that this recipe gives you an easy dinner idea that really amplifies the amazing feelings of the fall season! Until next time, stay tuned for more from Becca Bakes!

To help out the people trying to include their vegan friends, I can show you five recipes that vegans can eat.

The first recipe will be Potato Skins; this is a simple recipe. To start off, preheat the oven to 400 degrees. After preheating the oven, cut the potatoes in half. Then, you can either scoop out the potato until there is only a thin

layer of potato skin or you can scoop only part of the potato out. After doing so, pour some pizza sauce into the newly made potato dent. Then use some type of vegan cheese to place on the top of the pizza sauce. You can either leave the pizza that way or add vegan pepperoni, vegan sausage, or veggie toppings. When done personalizing your potato skins, put them in the oven for 20 minutes. After 20 minutes, your potato skins are finished and ready for the party.

Sweets are loved by many, including vegans! That is why the next recipe is Rice Krisp-



ie Treats. Making vegan Rice Krispie treats is a little different from regular ones as you have to make them with other

ingredients. The first thing you want to do is add vegan butter to a medium heated pan. After the butter has melted, add vegan marshmallows. Stir them together until the marshmallows look gooey. In a separate bowl, add one tablespoon of almond milk or oat milk, along with a pinch of salt. When that is done, add the gooey marshmallows to the bowl. Then stir until everything is mixed well. Add the mixture to your preferred tray (you can add food col-

oring to the rice krispies to make them look different). Wait a couple minutes for the marshmallows to set, then they are good to eat.

There are so many pizza places around the world, but pizza is better when made at home, since you can change or design it anyway you want to. The next recipe is mini halloween pizzas. First, preheat the oven to 400 degrees. Then get pizza crust that does not have eggs or milk in it, and cut it into mini shapes. When you are done cutting, find your pizza sauce and evenly spread it around your crust. Then, get the vegan cheese of your choice and put it on the top of the sauce. When Halloween rolls around there are always fake eyeballs, mummy's, ghosts, and severed finger snacks. Using crescent dough sheets we are going to make severed fingers. Preheat your oven to 325 degrees. Then cut horizontally four inches of dough (depending on how long your dough sheet is you might have to cut it in half). After that you want to get about two or three tablespoons of strawberry jam and equally spread it in the middle of your cut dough square. You then want to

roll the dough into a cylinder shape with the jam in the middle. Once you have done that you want to pinch the ends together so the jam does not leak out. Then put it into the oven for 30 minutes. When time is up let the finger's sit for about five to ten minutes, then you want to put a little bit of jam on one end of the finger so it looks severed. On the other end you want to push the crust down with a spoon. Then you want to put a pinch of jam on the part of the crust you just pushed down. You will then need to find an almond and cut it in

half. You want to take 1/2 of the almond and place it on the dented part of the finger. Place the 1/2 almond (white side up) gently on top of the pinch of jam so it looks like a fingernail. Then that is it, you are all done!

These recipes should help you include your vegan friends in the fun while at a party. Nobody likes being hungry at an entire party as it makes people want to leave so they can get something to eat. So make sure to include all your friends during your Halloween parties!

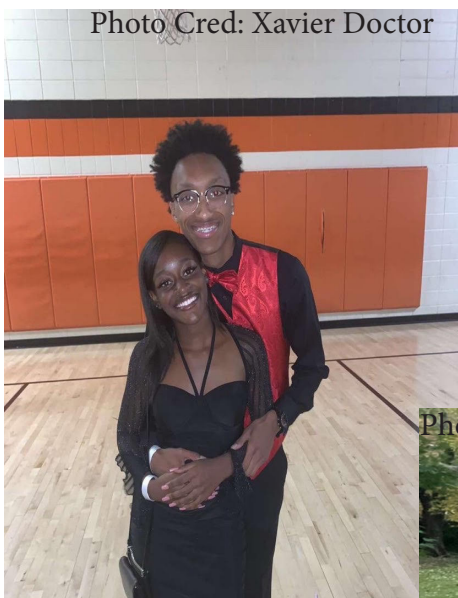

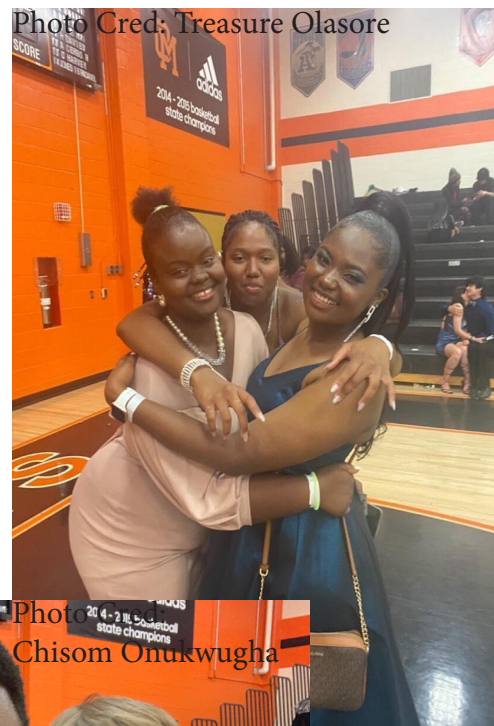

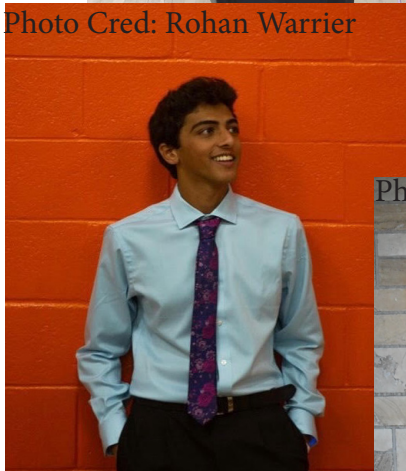

### INTRODUCTION
